Hiroto Miwa is emeritus professor of Hyogo University of Medicine, and currently the president of Kawanishi City Medical Hospital, which is located in Hyogo prefecture, Japan. He has retired from professor of Hyogo University of Medicine at the end of March, 2022. At his active duty, he was appointed as a vice-dean of the University as well as vice-president of University hospital. After graduation from Kagoshima University Medical School in 1982, he worked in Juntendo University Hospital in Tokyo, where he had been appointed as assistant and associate professor of the Gastroenterology department. From 1992-95, he studied at University of Michigan under supervision of Dr Yamada. He had been appointed as a professor of Hyogo University of Medicine in 2004. His main research interest is basic and clinical research for the diseases of GI tract, especially functional GI disorders including FD and IBS. He was the chairman of the functional dyspepsia guideline committee and constipation guideline committee of JSGE (Japanese society of gastroenterology). He is productive and has published more than 350 original and 90 review English articles in the international peer-review journals. He is deeply involved in many academic societies of GI, endoscopic and internal medicine. He served Asian Neurogastroenterology and Motility Association (ANMA) and Japanese Neurogastroenterology and Motility Society (JNMS) as a president until 2024 and 2023, respectively.
